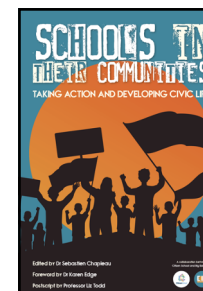
- 3) A further consideration is that as part of pedestrian and road safety improvements, the Council will shortly be introducing a zebra crossing in Homedale Road, near to the junction with Page Heath Lane (see drawing). This will reduce parking in Homedale Road by approximately eight vehicles, so you may wish to take this into account before making a decision on the proposed CPZ changes. Please be advised that there is a separate investigation underway at this time to establish views as to the siting of a second mini-roundabout or other possible junction improvement at the junction of Liddon & Homedale Roads, which could result in an as yet unquantified further loss of parking bays in the vicinity (most likely 5 or 6 lost bays).

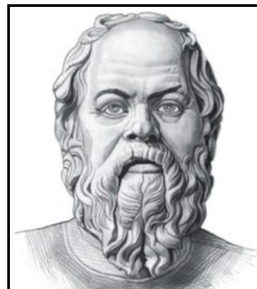
